One Click Grade Reporting for Parents

Online grade reporting became easier. Starting today when a parent logs into Edline, they will see the word "current grade" under the Contents heading (located on the right hand side of the screen). When the parent clicks on that word, the most current grades reported in the teacher's grade book will appear. All classes will appear in one place without navigating among different web pages. This will save time and convenience on the part of the teacher and parent. Daily updates for student grades will begin today and carry out through the entire school year.
